## Book of Maps & Association rules

It is hoped the information contained will enable you to make full use of the waters available, and to inform you of our rules.

### Map information

Maps are printed under licence from the Ordnance Survey. They must not be copied or passed to a third party.

**Grid references** are about the middle of the beat or at any road bridge on the beat.

Use O.S. Explorer 264 map. In all cases **left & right** are looking downstream.

**Length in m.** Is the approximate total length of beat in metres [sum of all banks.]

**Water details** include any relevant information about the beat.

**Parking.** It is your responsibility to ensure when parking it is safe & legal. Any parking area indicated on the maps is for guidance only & the club accept no liability for any accidents resulting from parking. **ALL TICKET HOLDERS PARK AT THEIR OWN RISK**

If fishing at night it is imperative to keep all noise to an **absolute minimum**. We are in danger of losing some of our night parking spots if the present trend of disturbing local residents continues.

### RULES OF THE ASSOCIATION

**All Ticket Holders when fishing the Association Waters shall strictly observe the following rules.**

- (a) A Ticket Holder upon request shall produce their Ticket Holders card and licence for inspection by another member who produces their own card, or to a bailiff, riparian owner or any person with lawful authority when fishing Association waters
- (b) Tickets are not transferable under any circumstances.
- (c) No person shall be permitted to fish association waters until such time as a day ticket is purchased, and they are in possession of the appropriate Environment Agency licence.
- (d) A Ticket Holder shall produce his bag or fish receptacle to any of the persons referred to in rule (a) above upon request when fishing Association waters.
- (e) A Ticket Holder shall observe all restrictions and regulations governing the Association waters.
- (f) No more than one rod may be used for fishing at any one time and no type of hand-line or nightline shall be allowed.
- (g) Each Ticket Holder shall take great care not to damage any walls or fences over which he might climb. If they find any wall or fence so damaged they shall repair it to the best of their ability on the spot and inform the secretary of the damage.
- (h) Each Ticket Holder shall take great care to close each gate, which they open.

- (i) No Ticket Holder shall walk through any ploughed field or a field containing growing crops or hay but shall keep strictly to the fisherman's path running along the bank.
- (j) A Ticket Holder shall not fish longer than 20 minutes at any one spot when another angler wishes to fish over it. Ticket Holders are asked to note that **spinning takes preference over bait and fly takes preference over spinning.**
- (k) No Ticket Holder shall be accompanied by a dog.
- (l) No Ticket Holder shall sell for profit any salmon, sea trout or trout caught in waters where the Association shall have had fishing rights or licence to fish granted to it.
- (m) No Ticket Holder, unless they hold a salmon licence, shall use a bait or lure (other than worms) exceeding 1¼ (one and one quarter) inches (32mm) in length. In the case of a spinning bait the hook shall not be counted in these measurements, but neither should the hooks be out of proportion to the bait or lure.
- (n) No Ticket Holder shall be allowed to take more than two brace of migratory fish or trout in any one day from any of the waters owned or leased by the Association. Ticket Holders shall not take more than three Salmon in any one-year.
- (o) Ticket Holders must strictly observe the rule "*no wading*" on Association waters where the owners object to this.
- (p) No Ticket Holder shall remove trout measuring less than 9 inches (23mm) from snout to fork of tail.
- (q) Every Ticket Holder shall endeavor to do everything he/she can to enhance the reputation of the Association and to maintain the good opinion of riparian owners and farmers.
- (r) No ground or feeder bait may be used.
- (s) No maggots or other non-aquatic larvae or pupae may be used.
- (t) No lead shot may be used at any time; only non-toxic substitute may be used in accordance with the River Authority bylaws.
- (u) Ticket Holders must at all times observe Environment Agency Bylaws as to seasons and restrictions on fishing.
- (v) There is to be no spinning or bait fishing between sunset and sunrise.
- (w) Catch returns must be made at the end of each session to the Hotel.
- (x) There shall be no coaching for profit on any of the Association waters unless permission is granted by the committee

**Non-observance of these rules shall be grounds for refusal of any future Tickets**
